## 1.1 Data

The description of settings located in the Data section of the Skin Settings item.

### 1.1.1 Do not include the /css/defaultstyles.css stylesheet (DoNotIncludeDefaultCSSfiles)

**Description:** The setting specifies whether a reference to the '/css/defaultstyles.css' file will be included in the page during its rendering (the check box is cleared) or not (the check box is selected). The file defines the default CSS classes used in Sitecore Intranet Portal, and it might automatically be overwritten when upgrading to newer versions of SIP. If you want to change any of these classes, modify them in the stylesheet definitions of the skin.

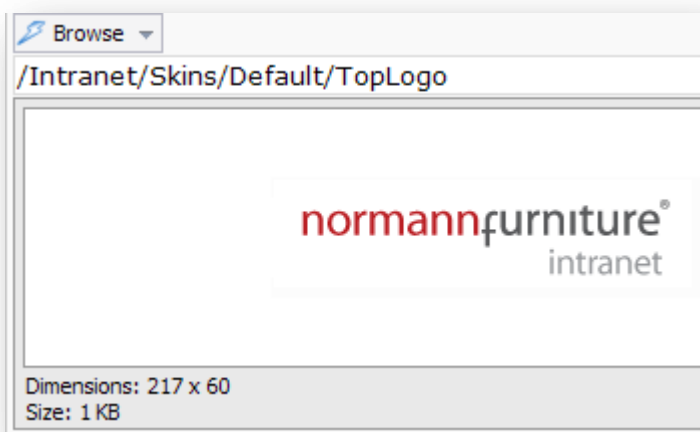

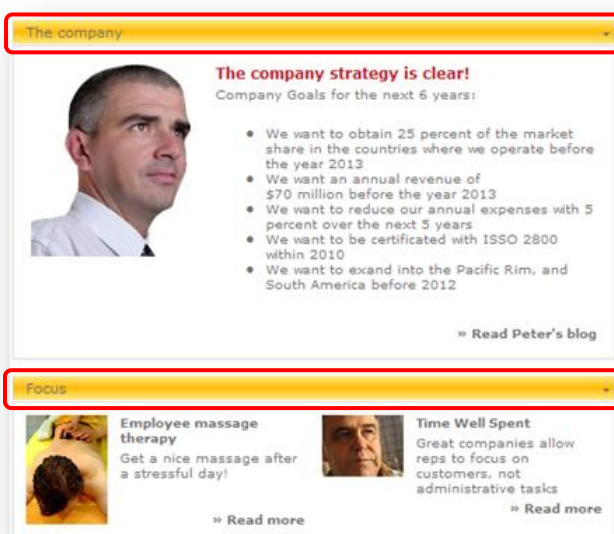




